

**Here are 10 ideas for a NEXT STEP you can take to assist the children who come to Presbyterian Children's Village.  
Little steps can make a big difference!**

1. **EDUCATE** your congregation about PCV programs and child welfare issues. Use **display materials, speakers, bulletin inserts, DVD screenings**....and more. Include PCV in your Mission Fair. (May is Foster Care Awareness month.)
2. **LINK** [www.pcv.org](http://www.pcv.org) to your church website for easy access to Village news and needs.
3. Become an **advocate** for children and families. Get on our e-list for alerts about challenges to child welfare services in our state and community.
4. **PARTNER** with PCV and the Philadelphia Presbytery in the **Zones of Peace** initiative. PCV can work with your congregation on a parent education project, foster parent recruitment and support, or other projects that align with our mission and yours.
5. **SHARE** our **wish lists** for specific needs: Christmas, after-school programs, backpacks and school supplies, arts & crafts supplies, family needs, hygiene kits, sports, and more. All are posted on the PCV website.
6. **VISIT** Presbyterian Children's Village at **Rosemont** or the **Preheim Center** (Southwest Philadelphia) with members, colleagues, and friends for a talk and tour or your own meeting in a different location.
7. Participate in **EASY GIVING**. Collect **Campbell's Labels** and **Box Tops for Education** to help our Village School purchase such items as digital cameras, office equipment, educational software, science materials, and more. Use **[www.OneCause.com](http://www.OneCause.com)** to donate a percent of your online shopping purchase to PCV. It's easy and it doesn't cost you anything!
8. **GIVE TIME: volunteer**. Opportunities include: tutor, recreational and life skills activities, administrative support, Career Night presentations, group work days and more. Opportunities are at both locations.
