Presbyterian Children's Village Celebrates 50th Anniversary in Rosemont, PA.

(Rosemont, PA): Guests of Presbyterian Children's Village and the Radnor Historical Society enjoyed an informative talk by architectural historian Jim Garrison and a tour of Robinson Hall, formerly part of the estate of Samuel Robinson, co-founder of the Acme Markets. The event on September 26 was part of PCV's celebration its 50-year anniversary in Rosemont. Presbyterian Children's Village has been assisting children and families in the greater Philadelphia area since 1877.

Founded as an orphanage in 1877, Presbyterian Children's Village today is a non-profit corporation dedicated to the healing of the spirits of children, families and communities broken by violence, addiction, poverty, mental illness, racism and other serious societal problems. The Village serves more than 5,100 children each year in the greater Philadelphia area.
