Presbyterian Children's Village Receives Grant from the Ladies Aid Society of Presbyterian Medical Center of Philadelphia

(Rosemont, PA) The Presbyterian Children's Village has received a \$20,262 grant from the Ladies Aid Society of Presbyterian Medical Center of Philadelphia to support arts programming for teens in the Residential Treatment Program during the 2010-2011 academic year. The grant will fund art classes and a Music Therapy Program throughout the academic year.

Every PCV resident will have the opportunity to attend fine arts classes, either on campus or at the Main Line Art Center, and a new music therapy program provided by Music Works.

The Residential Treatment Program serves adolescents 13 to 18 years old with serious mental health and behavioral issues. It is a state-licensed and JCAHO-accredited residential treatment facility on the Rosemont Campus offering clinical treatment; a state licensed special education school for students with emotional, social, and special learning needs; 24-hour structured supervision; and psychiatric services.

Founded as an orphanage in 1877, Presbyterian Children's Village today is a non-profit corporation dedicated to the healing of the spirits of children, families and communities broken by violence, addiction, poverty, mental illness, racism and other serious societal problems.
