Presbyterian Children's Village Receives Grant from the Ethel Sergeant Clark Smith Memorial Fund

(Rosemont, PA) The Presbyterian Children's Village has received a \$10,000 grant from the Ethel Sergeant Clark Smith Memorial Fund (West Chester, PA) to help support the special education needs of disadvantaged adolescents from Delaware County who participate in the Residential Treatment Program and attend the on-campus Village School.

The on-campus, State-licensed Secondary School for students with emotional, social, and special learning needs is an integral component of the Residential Treatment Program. The licensed Private Academic Special Education School at the Rosemont campus was established in 1982 to meet the challenging needs of the residential students and to provide small, structured classrooms with a low teacher to student ratio. The Village School serves approximately 125 students each year.

Founded as an orphanage in 1877, Presbyterian Children's Village today is a non-profit corporation dedicated to the healing of the spirits of children, families and communities broken by violence, addiction, poverty, mental illness, racism and other serious societal problems.
