Kristy Filler joins Presbyterian Children's Village as Vice President of Programs

(Rosemont, PA): Presbyterian Children's Village is pleased to announce that **Kristy Filler** has joined the staff as the Assistant Director of Residential Treatment/Director of Cottage Life. She will be responsible the administration and supervision of services provided through the Cottage Life Program in the Village Residential Treatment Facility.

Filler, a licensed clinical social worker, comes to the Village from Terry Children's Psychiatric Center (New Castle, DE). She has previously worked for Crossroads of Delaware (Wilmington, DE), Snowden & Grace Cottages (Wilmington, DE), the Ferris School (Wilmington, DE), and the Archdiocese of Philadelphia (De La Salle Aftercare). She received her Master of Social Work from Widener University and her Bachelors of Sciences in Criminal Justice from the Pennsylvania State University.

The Residential Treatment Program serves adolescents 13 to 18 years old with serious mental health and behavioral issues. It is a state-licensed and JCAHO-accredited residential treatment facility on the Rosemont Campus offering clinical treatment; a state licensed special education school for students with emotional, social, and special learning needs; 24-hour structured supervision (the Cottage Life Program); and psychiatric services.

Founded as an orphanage in 1877, Presbyterian Children's Village today is a non-profit corporation dedicated to the healing of the spirits of children, families and communities broken by violence, addiction, poverty, mental illness, racism and other serious societal problems.
