Stephani Finnin joins Presbyterian Children's Village As Coordinator of Educational Services

(Rosemont, PA) Presbyterian Children's Village is pleased to announce that **Stephani Finnin** has joined the staff as the Coordinator of Educational Services. She will be responsible for supervising the educational services for students in the Village Residential Treatment Program.

Finnin comes to the Village from Community Education Partners in Philadelphia. She has worked at West Philadelphia High School, South Philadelphia High School, The Chester County Intermediate Unit. Finnin received her BSED in English and MED in Counseling Education from West Chester University and her Principal's Certificate from The Pennsylvania State University.

The Residential Treatment Program serves adolescents 13 to 18 years old with serious mental health and behavioral issues. It is a state-licensed and JCAHO-accredited residential treatment facility on the Rosemont Campus offering clinical treatment; a state licensed special education school for students with emotional, social, and special learning needs; 24-hour structured supervision; and psychiatric services.

Founded as an orphanage in 1877, Presbyterian Children's Village today is a non-profit corporation dedicated to the healing of the spirits of children, families and communities broken by violence, addiction, poverty, mental illness, racism and other serious societal problems. The Village serves more than 7,100 children each year in the greater Philadelphia area.
