Presbyterian Children's Village Receives Sunoco Grant *Sunoco Helps Improve Lives in Southwest Philadelphia*

(Rosemont, PA) The Presbyterian Children's Village has received a \$3,500 grant from Sunoco, Inc. (Philadelphia, PA) to support the services to children and families in Southwest Philadelphia. These include the Parent Education Program, the Behavioral Health program, the After School and Summer Programs for children, and the Community Celebration event to promote awareness of these programs.

The Preheim Center provides a wide range of crucial community-based services and prevention programs for at-risk and traumatized children and families. These include foster care, kinship care, adoption, In Home Protective Service (IHPS) programs, mental health services, truancy services, after-school programs, and more. In all, the Village serves about 5,100 children and families each year, encouraging healthy familial ties and strengthening the communities in the Greater Philadelphia region from its two facilities. The Village also provides residential services from its headquarters in Rosemont. More information can be found at www.pcv.org.

Founded as an orphanage in 1877, Presbyterian Children's Village today is a non-profit corporation dedicated to the healing of the spirits of children, families and communities broken by violence, addiction, poverty, mental illness, racism and other serious societal problems.
